

■ Eligibility

Applicant must be 13-16 years old, have been an active member for one year, and have held an office in her Junior Girls Unit. Previous winners are not eligible, but former applicants who did not receive one of the top National Scholarships may re-apply.

■ Judging Criteria

Scholarship winners will be judged on the following point system:

Junior Unit Activities	40 Points
School Activities	30 Points
Scholastic Grades	30 Points

In addition, judges will consider the neatness and creativity used in completing the application.

■ Rules

■ Application must be accompanied by letters of recommendation on letterhead stationery from a school teacher, Youth Activities Chairman (see note under procedures), and one other person of the applicant's choice.

■ A school transcript must be included.

■ Please answer all application questions as completely as possible. Judges will use the application and accompanying items mentioned in the first two rules to base their decisions. Additional material is unnecessary.

■ Completed application, three recommendations, and school transcript must be submitted or APPLICATION WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.

■ Application must be submitted to Auxiliary Youth Activities Chairman for judging.

■ The Ladies Auxiliary Chairman will send only the winning application from the Unit to the Department Youth Activities Chairman for judging and **ONLY THE WINNING APPLICATION** from the Department will be forwarded to National Headquarters for the National competition.

■ All material submitted as entries becomes the property of the National Headquarters and will **NOT** be returned to the applicant.

■ If winners do not complete schooling of at least one year, any money not used from the Scholarship Fund will be refundable to the Ladies Auxiliary to the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States.

■ Scholarships

One outstanding Junior Girls Unit member will be selected to receive the scholarship, which is held in escrow at National Headquarters and disbursed as needed until the scholarship is totally withdrawn. The scholarship is paid directly to the American college, university, or vocational/technical school as selected by the recipient. Disbursement is made upon receipt of proper notice from the school certifying that the recipient is accepted and is enrolled. The funds may be used for tuition, books, laboratory fees, and/or other items relating specifically to the student's formal education. Clothing, room and board, and pocket money are not considered authorized expenditures.

\$7,500 First Place

The Plaque will be mailed to the Department for presentation at the winner's school, if possible.

In addition, \$100 will be awarded to each Junior Girl who is selected as the Department winner and entered in the National competition. National first place winner of the scholarship will not receive the \$100 award.

■ Deadlines

Student Deadline: March 11.

Department Deadline: Unit Entries must be received by Department Chairmen on March 25.

National Deadline: Department Winners must be received at National Headquarters by April 7.

Junior Girls Scholarship Application Procedures



To apply for the Junior Girls Scholarship, please send one letter of recommendation from a person of your choice, one from a school teacher, and one from your Auxiliary Youth Activities Chairman (note: If she is a relative, the letter should be from your Ladies Auxiliary or Post leader.) Submit a grade transcript from your school. (If grade point system is different than 4.0 system, please have school convert grades to 4.0.) Finally, please provide the following information on no more than five 8 1/2" x 11" sheets of paper. All four categories--Personal, Junior Girls Unit, School Activities Participation, and Scholastic Information--must be answered, the above mentioned materials submitted, and the requested signatures included for the application to be considered complete.
